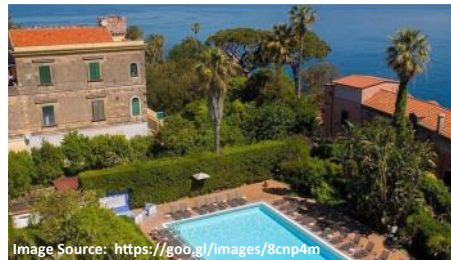
MONDAY 8TH JULY 2019

The **Colosseum** in Rome is also known as the Flavian Amphitheatre because it was built during the Flavian dynasty. It got the name Colosseum because a statue located alongside the amphitheatre was called 'the Colossus of Nero'.

Mount Vesuvius is about 4,190 feet high and measures about 30 miles around its base. Geologists estimate it to be about 17,000 years old. **Vesuvius** is the only volcano on the European mainland that has erupted during the last century and is still active.

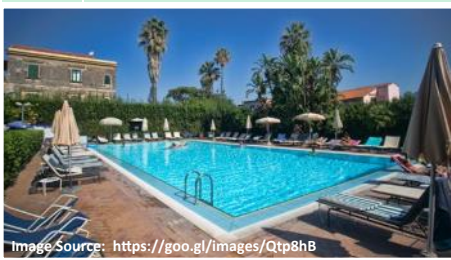

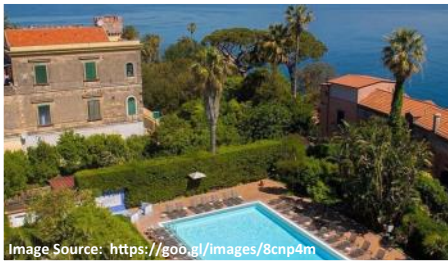

Pompeii was an ancient Roman city that was destroyed and buried under 4 to 6 meters (13 to 20 feet) of volcanic ash and pumice in the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD.

Capri was a favourite resort for the Roman Emperor Augustus and the island was made famous by Tiberius in 27 AD, who made Capri his home for the last decade of his life.

Sitting atop a grand staircase in the centre of town, the **Cathedral of St. Andrew in Amalfi** is one of Campania's architectural highlights and is home to the relics of Sant'Andrea, or St. Andrew, the patron saint and protector of Amalfi.

AM Drive down the Amalfi Coast to the town of Amalfi

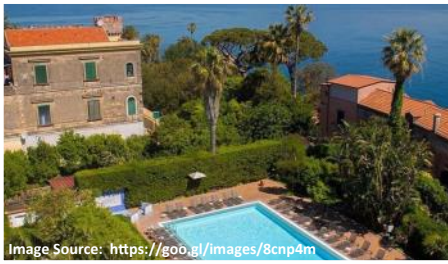


AM Explore the town of Amalfi and visit the spectacular cathedral
