Non-uniform day and Sponsored Fun Run

On Friday 17th March 2023, there will be a **non- uniform** day where students can wear something red, fancy dress or general non-uniform if they prefer. We ask that where students choose to wear their own normal clothing that this is appropriate. For example, crop-tops should not be worn.

During lesson 5, all students will take part in a whole-school Fun Run that will take them: around the school ground and footpath in Bullpit Meadow, along Bridge Street and along the pavement, through the town and return back to school via the zebra crossing. All parts of the course will be well staffed, and Sixth Form students will collect money in buckets if any community members want to contribute.
